The testimonies listed below give you a glimpse of their background. Though each story is different, it reflects the same love of our Lord, Jesus Christ. It is His love that empowers each student to turn over his/her life to serve those who have not heard about Him.

With their permission, we share their stories that teach us humility and the power of His love.

Jason: "Our family would host missionary families that were in the United States raising funds often, and at a very young age, I was captivated by the presence of these missionaries, and their stories of reaching people in the remotest parts of the world with the Gospel of Jesus Christ....I feel that God has called me to found an orphanage and raise the children God will send, in strong relationship with Him, and for the purpose of being leaders in Latin America."

Jaebong: "My special interest is in China mission... Underground churches are growing under the protection of God. What the churches in China needs the most is theological education and the support for church leaders. I pray to God that He would equip me and use me to help Chinese people and churches in His time with His method."

Leah: "I have been on five short-term mission trips to Mexico, including one month with a missionary family, ... Last summer, I volunteered at a YWAM base in Romania working with street kids. The Lord used those times to soften my heart for the lost and hurting. My desire is to meet the broken and wounded with Jesus' love. I am interested in ministering to Muslims and other unreached people groups, and in pursuit of this I am focusing on Islam in my studies."

Deborah: "My husband and I have passion for China mission... My church asked me to be a director of Mandarin Young Adults Group as volunteer. The goal is to reach Chinese international students in Southern California. I am praying for that they go back to China as a native missionary and influence their family, friends, and all over the country. Owing to your support I could commit myself to seminary studying and ministry instead of doing part time job."

Tessa: "I was first challenged to share my faith with others in high school, and throughout college participated in a variety of evangelistic and mission outreaches.... My two years of full time ministry had affirmed my vocational call to missions, and I desired the training that seminary provides. When I graduate from ... I have every intention of moving overseas to work as a missionary."

Jessy: "...God chose me not only as a seed of gospel in my family, but also to be His handmaid, whatever He wants me to do and wherever He sends me to go, I'm willing to obey and follow.... God placed me in Christian and Missionary Alliance church involving the church-planting ministry for 8 years in which I have opportunities to develop my spiritual gifts and learn more about mission."

Deborah：我與我的丈夫對中國特別有負擔，我現在參加的教會邀請我開始一個國語青年聚會，目的是向南加州的中國留學生傳福音，求神用這些留學生，將來成為宣教士回到他們的家鄉把福音廣傳，因著你們所提供的獎學金，我可以專心完成神學課程及目前的教會事奉。

Tessa：我在中學及大學時期，神不斷給我傳福音的機會，同時也多次參與宣教工作，過去兩年半的神學訓練，更加深我去宣教的熱誠，畢業後，求神帶領我到海外作宣教士。

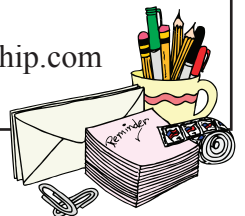
