Investment with Guarantee

Investment is to sacrifice present enjoyment, and multiply the saved dollars over time. Investment requires two essentials. One has to see the importance in the future. Secondly, one wants to make profits, or it does not justify the risks involved.

Investment, in general terms, refers to banking, financial and real estate. In addition, it refers to people – investment in education and skills training. Chinese put strong emphasis in this category. Parents invest in children their patience, money and other sacrifices to help them excel.

All investments mentioned above have direct or indirect relationships with us. There is one exception that is often overlooked - to invest in God's eternal kingdom, specifically investing in God's servants. Let us take a look. A seminary student graduates and answers the call to a mission field. He/she brings the good news to the unheard. One by one, they enter into the kingdom. It is easy to see the profitable return of investing in seminary students. It is an investment that involves no risk and brings multi-fold returns.

Some may not know how to invest. Investments always involve various degrees of risks, the higher the risk, the higher the returns. However, investing in God's kingdom compared to earthly investments, involves no risk but Godly blessings.

There are several avenues of

investment in God's kingdom:

1. direct participation
2. cash participation
3. prayer

To the majority, the first option is the most important and the other two are easier to carry out. In reality, lacking any one of these cannot bring success. The bible recorded David and his wars (I Samuel 30:23-25). The plunders were evenly distributed to the warriors in the front line and the guardians of weapons in the rear.

We are promised that all of us can enjoy God's blessings like multifold returns to our investments. Below is the return of your generous investment:

Since the establishment of Harvesters in 2002, a total of \$61,000 of scholarships has been granted to eighteen seminary students. Six of the recipients completed their studies and preparation. 有價值的投資

投資乃是省下現在可享用的，以換取將來多倍的收穫。投資的第一個基本要素是：重視將來的價值。第二個基本要素：是盼望能夠多倍收穫，否則不值得多此一舉，白白冒險。

一般說投資，多偏重於財務、金錢和土地方面的投資。其實投資涵蓋更多方面，例如：人資，是投資於教育和特技之訓練。中國人對此特別強調，莘莘學子，在父母費盡心血、金錢及數不盡的犧牲與付出，為的是望子成龍，望女成鳳。

以上所提的幾種投資，都是與自己本身有直接或間接關係的。還有一些投資，似乎與自己沒有直接的關係，因此常被忽略，在此特別提出有關對神永恆工作方面的投資，尤其是造就神國工人方面的投資。我們若仔細分析一下，當一個神學生畢業後，進入宣教工場事奉，領人歸主，將神國的事工拓展開來，我們不難領會到這是一種有意義，名符其實的投資，它的效果是長遠的，功效是多倍的。我們有了這樣的看見，就不會把奉獻看成一種犧牲或損失，而是有價值的。

常有人覺得不知道如何投資，因為一般投資總有些冒險，只是程度不同而已，而且似乎冒險性大的，收效也可能大些。但是在神的工作上投資，與一般世上的投資，比較起來，全無冒險性，因為神自己加上了祝福。這方面的投資有多種方式；(1)直接參與一人去。(2)金錢奉獻。(3)禱告。對大多數的人來講，最可能做到的是，金錢與禱告的投資。或許有人會以為人去是最重要，其實這三樣缺一不可。聖經上有關大衛打仗的事(撒下三十：23-25)告訴我們上陣的得多少，看守兵器的也得多少，沒有後方前陣之別，我們也能一同享受工作的果效，好像投資獲得

加倍成果的喜悅一樣。

我想藉著本會訊，讓讀者知道，在造就神工人的事工上，您有很好的投資機會。

收割者獎學金自2002年成立以來，已支助十八位神學生，總共頒發了\$61,000獎學金。感謝主！其中有六位已經完成他們的神學課程和裝備，並分佈在不同的宣教工場事奉。
