Application Guidelines

The following are the minimum requirements that must be met before a candidate will be considered for scholarship:

1. A Christian testimony/personal statement
2. Responding to the calling of becoming a missionary upon graduation
3. Enrollment in a qualified undergraduate or graduate institution in the US or Canada.
4. Full time enrollment as student
5. 3.0 G.P.A. or higher
6. Financial need. Combined income of parents and student is below \$60,000. Student's natural and step parents' incomes are included in that income ceiling, as well as "parsonage allowances" which are often part of the pay package to families in ministry.
